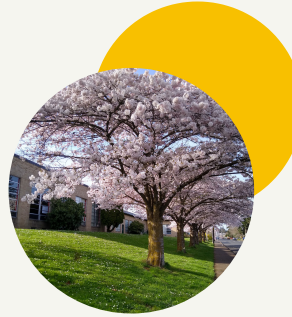


Oliver Lent PTA

A year in review

Events

In lieu of in person events, the PTA held monthly online events during our regular business meeting times.

These included:

Advocacy

A year of remote school and social unrest as well as preplanned changes gave opportunity to discuss the future in different ways. The Lent PTA worked with other SouthEast regional PTAs to advocate for our communities in two areas of concern:

1. In Fall 2020 the Lent PTA sent a letter in response to proposed boundary and enrollment changes to the school board.
2. In Winter 2021 the PTA responded to talks of MAP testing remote students with a letter against standardized testing. This was followed by a conversation testing efficacy research between the PTA and a school board member.
